PROGRAMME FOCUS AREAS:

Climate Change Ambassadors

Support South Africa's efforts to combat climate change by participating in initiatives related to climate change mitigation, adaptation, disaster risk reduction, and the development of early warning systems to build resilient communities.

Forestry Monitors

Contribute to the sustainable management and protection of forests, promoting their social and economic value and supporting development through monitoring and advocacy.

Waste Campaigners

Help raise awareness in communities about the harmful effects of illegal dumping and littering. Participate in education and outreach campaigns promoting sustainable waste management practices and environmental well-being.

Occupational Health and Safety (OHS) Compliance Officers

Ensure health and safety compliance across EPWP projects. Participants will support the implementation of OHS regulations in environmental workspaces and enhance workplace safety, particularly under Youth Graduate initiatives.

Must hold a minimum of M+3 qualification in one of the following (or related) fields:

Environmental Management

Environmental Science

Occupational Health and Safety

Or other relevant environmental disciplines
